

CIBOLO VALLEY BAPTIST CHURCH BUSINESS MEETING
February 10, 2016

Cibolo Valley Baptist Church met for the regular scheduled business meeting, February 10, 2016.

The meeting was opened in prayer led by Joe Thele.

Minutes of the December meeting were presented. A motion was made by Ed Salzwedel to accept the minutes as presented. Joe Thele seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Gloria Hill presented the treasurer's report, explained overages, and answered questions. Link Linkenhoger made a motion to accept the report as presented. The motion was seconded by Joe Thele and the motion carried.

REPORTS:

Other attached reports were to be reviewed by members at their leisure. The reports included the written Prayer Ministry, Sunday School, Missions, and Church Clerk Reports.

OLD BUSINESS:

Property and Space: Jim Gardner reported the metal work is being done and they should be installed by the end of February. Jim advised members metal gates are being ordered to be placed at each entrance to the church property. This is to prevent people from driving into the church parking lot after hours. Jim stated he is hoping the church will be able to install new flooring from the education building all the way up to the sanctuary this year. Time Warner will be installing new equipment next week. Painting of the exterior doors will start tomorrow, February 11th.

Mission Trips – C. J. Williams reported on the planned mission trips. Joe and Bobbi Thele are the coordinators for the Oklahoma trip and currently have twenty-one (21) people signed up to go. Prayer is needed for the Las Vegas and Del Rio trips. There currently three (3) people signed up for the Las Vegas trip. A decision will be made about the Del Rio trip to City Church by the end of February.

Cottage Meetings – June Noggle reported the Cottage Meetings have started and everyone is encouraged to attend. June reported there were six (6) people at George and Stella Herro's home, four (4) at Joe and Mary Zigungske's, and two (2) at Les and Gloria Hill's.

NEW BUSINESS:

New Members: Church Clerk, Gloria Hill, presented Juan and Janeen Woods, Madonna Ashitey, Rodney and Isabel Fodge, Suzanne Brenckman, and Troy and Eve Johnson to be voted in as new members. Gloria also stated Cheri Kasper was being dismissed from the membership rolls as she is deceased. Gloria Hill made a motion to accept the listed individuals as members and remove Cheri from the rolls. The motion was seconded and the motion carried.

New Ministry – Don Peterson presented the idea of a new ministry to the church members. The idea is to use a sign to get people to come in and their questions be answered. Don Peterson made a motion to have an evangelism ministry at 7 PM on Thursday evening and 10 AM on Saturday morning. Don will lead the ministry/ C. J. Williams seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Nominating Committee – Gloria Hill present the Nominating Committee recommendations. Gloria Hill made a motion to change the Nursery Workers job description wording to change the guarantee of three (3) hours to one (1) hour. Joe Thele seconded the motion and the motion carried. Gloria Hill presented Joy Jones' request to step down as Treasurer, but be a member of the Stewardship Committee. Gloria made a motion this request be accepted. Charles Burks seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Tabernacle at CVBC – Jim Gardner reported he has been talking to someone about bringing the Tabernacle back to the church property. However, there will be no Tabernacle at CVBC for now. Jim will continue to work on this for now.


Next Work Day – Jim Gardner stated the next workday will be March 19th after the Men's Breakfast.

Next Business Meeting – The next business meeting will be April 13, 2016 after the Fellowship meal.

Inner City Ministry – Gloria Hill advised members the Inner City Ministry led by Robert and Carol Davis is being discontinued in the San Antonio area. Robert and Carol have both had strokes and have moved out of San Antonio and left SABA. Gloria stated the church would need to decide what to do with the budgeted funds of \$200.00. It was decided to table this matter for now and have the Stewardship Committee come back with a recommendation for members to consider. The matter will be addressed at the next business meeting in April.
